BELL ATLANTIC, GTE AND VODAFONE SEEK CONSENT TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF OR ASSIGN PROPERTIES TO DIVESTITURE TRUST

PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED

Comments/Petitions: June 12, 2000 Replies/Opposition: June 22, 2000

On May 3 and 4, 2000, Bell Atlantic Corporation or its affiliates or subsidiaries ("Bell Atlantic"), GTE Corporation or its affiliates or subsidiaries ("GTE"), and Vodafone AirTouch Plc or its affiliates or subsidiaries ("Vodafone") filed applications under Section 310(d) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 310(d), seeking Commission consent to assign or transfer control of certain cellular, PCS, and microwave licenses to a trustee selected by the Department of Justice ("DOJ") and approved by the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia. The Applicants state that the purpose of the trust will be to facilitate the closing of the proposed merger of GTE and Bell Atlantic¹ consistent with the Commission's cellular cross-ownership and spectrum aggregation rules and a Consent Decree between Bell Atlantic, GTE, Vodafone, and DOJ.² The parties seek to divest the subject licenses to third parties in advance of the planned merger. In the event that they are unable to do so, however, the parties request authority to assign or transfer control of the licenses targeted for divestiture to the trustee.
