**Neoworld License Holdings, Inc.,
Hughes Electronics Corporation, and Wilmington Trust Company
Seek FCC Consent for Assignment
of 900 MHz Specialized Mobile Radio Licenses**

Neoworld License Holdings, Inc. ("Neoworld"), Hughes Electronics Corporation ("Hughes"), and Wilmington Trust Company, Liquidating Trustee, ("Wilmington Trust") have filed applications pursuant to Section 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 310(d), seeking Commission consent to assign various 900 MHz Specialized Mobile Radio ("SMR") licenses and authorizations held by Hughes or Wilmington Trust to Neoworld, a Delaware corporation. Hughes and Wilmington Trust recently acquired these licenses from the bankruptcy estate of Geotek Communications, Inc.¹
