ORDER

By the Chief, Market Disputes Resolution Division, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This matter comes before the Commission on the Joint Motion of Timothy E. Welch and Hill and Welch (Complainants) and Midcom Long Distance Network, MC Liquidating Corporation, and Winstar Communications, Inc. (Defendants) to Dismiss With Prejudice (“Joint Motion”) the above-captioned complaint.

2. We are satisfied that dismissing the complaint with prejudice will serve the public interest by promoting the private resolution of disputes and by eliminating the need for further litigation and the expenditure of further time and resources of the parties and of this Commission.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to sections 1, 4(i), 4(j), 201(b), and 208 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 151, 154(i), 154(j), and 208, and the authority delegated in sections 0.111 and 0.311 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.111, 0.311, that the parties’ Joint Motion To Dismiss With Prejudice IS GRANTED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-captioned complaint (*i.e.*, E-98-19) IS DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE and that this proceeding is TERMINATED.
