ORDER

By the Chief, Market Disputes Resolution Division, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This matter comes before the Commission on the Consent Motion for Withdrawal of Formal Complaint filed by MAP Mobile Communications, Inc. (MAP Mobile). MAP Mobile seeks to dismiss with prejudice the above-captioned complaint filed against U S West Communications, Inc. (U S West).¹ The complaint addresses, among other things, whether against U S WEST assessed illegal transport and termination charges on MAP Mobile.

2. We are satisfied that granting this motion to dismiss with prejudice will serve the public interest by promoting private resolution of disputes and by eliminating the need for further litigation and the expenditure of further time and resources of the parties and the Commission.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to sections 1, 4(i), 4(j), and 208 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 151, 154(i), 154(j), and 208, and the authority delegated in sections 0.111 and 0.311 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.111 and 0.311, that the Consent Motion for Withdrawal of Formal Complaint IS GRANTED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-captioned complaint is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE and that this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
