AT&T WITHDRAWS SITE PLAN FOR CONSTRUCTION OF FIBER OPTIC SIGNAL REGENERATION FACILITY NEAR BURKITTSVILLE, MD - RE: COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 214 AND ENVIRONMENTAL AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER NEPA AND NHPA – FILE CLOSED

On December 30, 1999, the Common Carrier Bureau released public notice DA 99-3025, "Comments Sought on AT&T Communications Construction of Fiber Optic Signal Regeneration Facility Near Burkittsville, MD - Re: Compliance with Section 214 and Environmental and Historic Preservation Requirements Under NEPA and NHPA - NSD File No: NSD-L-99-103."

On February 7, 2000, pending Commission review of the record, AT&T filed a letter advising the Commission that it withdrew its site plan for the project, opting to build at an alternate site. AT&T states that its decision to use an alternate site makes this proceeding moot. NSD File No. L-99-103 will therefore be closed.
