MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

By the Chief, Consumer Protection and Competition Division, Cable Services Bureau:

1. On October 27, 2000, Young Broadcasting of Lansing, Inc. ("Young"), licensee of Station WLNS-TV (CBS, Ch. 6), Lansing, Michigan, filed a complaint against MediaOne of Eastern Michigan, Inc. ("MediaOne"), operator of a cable system serving Livingston County, Michigan. On November 2, 2000, Young filed a motion to withdraw the complaint because MediaOne has reinstated carriage of WLNS-TV on its system.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the complaint of Young Broadcasting of Lansing, Inc. **IS DISMISSED**.

3. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by Section 0.321 of the Commission's rules.¹
