WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU APPROVES WITHDRAWAL OF PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION AND RECISSION

On May 17, 1995, Capitol Radiotelephone Company, Inc. (Capitol) filed a Petition for Reconsideration and Recission (Petition) of the Commission's April 18, 1995, renewal of Ram Technologies, Inc.'s private carrier paging license, call sign WNJN621.
