On March 1, 2000, GTE Service Corporation ("GTE") filed a Petition for Waiver of the Commission's affiliate transactions rules. In its petition, GTE requests that the Commission waive §32.27(c) of its rules to allow GTE to continue to record transactions with its separate services affiliate at fully distributed cost without incurring the obligation to obtain a market valuation study. GTE claims that this waiver is for a limited time period until contracts with former GTE affiliates have expired.
