On May 4, 2001, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.16(a), the North American Billing and Collection, Inc. (NBANC) submitted the contribution factor and fund size estimate for funding North American Numbering Plan Administration for the period July 2001 through June 2002.¹ The NBANC Board of Directors, by resolution at its May 1, 2001 meeting, authorized the contribution factor filed therein.

The NBANC Board of Directors recommends that the current contribution factor of 0.000043 remain in effect for the upcoming fund year until issues regarding the implementation of thousands-block number pooling, audits, and a replacement for the Central Office Code Utilization Survey (COCUS) are resolved.
