On May 16, 2001, the Competitive Telecommunications Association (CompTel), pursuant to Section 1.401 of the Commission's Rules, petitioned the Commission to initiate a rulemaking proceeding revising its policies governing the federally-tariffed charges of incumbent local exchange carriers (ILECs) for changing the presubscribed interexchange carrier for end-user subscribers.

Other rules pertaining to oral and written *ex parte* presentations in permit-but-disclose proceedings are set forth in Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b).
