ORDER

By the Chief, Consumer Protection and Competition Division, Cable Services Bureau:

1. Philadelphia Choice Television, Inc. d/b/a Popvision (“Popvision”) filed a Petition for Special Relief asserting that Comcast Cablevision of Philadelphia (“Comcast”) violated the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“Communications Act”) and Section 76.984 of the Commission’s rules by engaging in predatory pricing practices. By letter dated May 31, 2001, Popvision moved to dismiss its Petition for Special Relief.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the Petition for Special Relief filed by Philadelphia Choice Television, Inc. d/b/a Popvision in the above-captioned proceeding is **HEREBY DISMISSED**.
