MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Adopted: August 14, 2001

Released: August 16, 2001

By the Chief, Consumer Protection and Competition Division, Cable Services Bureau:

1. On May 10, 1999, the Bureau released an order granting, in part, open video system complaints filed by Media General Cable of Fairfax, Inc. and Media General Cable of Fredericksburg, Inc. (“Media General”) against Starpower Communications, LLC (“Starpower”).¹ On June 9, 1999, Starpower filed a petition for partial reconsideration of the Bureau’s order.

2. On August 2, 2001, Media General informed the Bureau that the cable operator is no longer interested in pursuing its complaints against Starpower, due to the fact that Media General sold the cable systems in question.²

3. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the May 10, 1999 order in this matter **IS VACATED**, as the initiating parties no longer have an interest in the subject matter of their complaints.
