By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. This Order dismisses the Request for Review filed by New Plymouth School District No. 372 (New Plymouth), New Plymouth, Idaho, seeking review of a decision issued by the Universal Service Administrative Company's Schools and Libraries Division on January 18, 2001.¹ The Commission received New Plymouth's Request for Review on February 20, 2001.² Under section 54.720 of the Commission's rules, any such appeal must be filed within 30 days of the issuance of the decision as to which review is sought.³ Documents are considered to be filed with the Commission only upon receipt.⁴ Because the instant Request for Review was not filed within the specified 30-day period, it will be dismissed without further consideration.
