THRIFTY CALL FILES PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING **PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED**

On August 7, 2001, Thrifty Call, Inc. (TCI) filed a petition for declaratory ruling seeking clarification of the meaning and application of certain terms contained in the Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. In particular, TCI requests that the Commission give definitive meaning to the percentage interstate usage (PIU) provisions in BellSouth's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. Interested parties may file comments no later than October 17, 2001. Reply comments may be filed no later than October 29, 2001. When filing comments, please reference CCB-CPD File No. 01-17. An original and four copies of all comments and reply comments must be filed with the Office of the Secretary, Federal Communications Commission, 445 12th Street, S.W., Room TW-A225, Washington, D.C. 20554. In addition, one copy of each submission must be filed with Qualex International, the Commission's duplicating contractor, at its office at Portals II, 445 12th Street, S.W., Room CY-B402, Washington, D.C. 20554, and one copy with the Chief, Competitive Pricing Division, 445 12th Street, S.W., Room 5-A225, Washington, D.C. 20554.

This proceeding shall be treated as a "permit-but-disclose" proceeding in accordance with the Commission's ex parte rules. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.1200 and 1.1206. Persons making oral ex parte presentations are reminded that memoranda summarizing the presentations must contain summaries of the substance of the presentations and not merely a listing of the subjects discussed. More than a one or two sentence description of the views and arguments presented is generally required. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b). Other rules pertaining to oral and written ex parte presentations in permit-but-disclose proceedings are set forth in section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b).
