The Region 1 (Alabama) 700 MHz Public Safety Planning Committee announces that its first meeting will be held on Thursday, January 24, 2002, at 10:00 a.m. at the Mobile County Communications District Building at 7340 Zeigler Boulevard, Mobile, Alabama. The purpose of the meeting is to:

1. Establish a 700 MHz Regional Planning Committee,
2. Elect a chairperson.

The Region 1 700 MHz Public Safety Planning Committee meeting is open to the public. All eligible public safety providers in Alabama would utilize these frequencies. It is essential that participants be representatives of all eligible public safety providers in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process.
