## QWEST WITHDRAWS PETITION FOR PRICING FLEXIBILITY FOR SPECIAL ACCESS AND DEDICATED TRANSPORT SERVICES

### CCB/CPD File No. 01-18

On October 10, 2001, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a petition for pricing flexibility for special access and dedicated transport services pursuant to Sections 1.774 and 69.701 *et seq.* of the Commission's rules.<sup>1</sup> The Commission established a pleading cycle for the petition,<sup>2</sup> and received comments from interested parties and reply comments from Qwest. On December 4, 2001, Qwest filed a request to withdraw its petition.<sup>3</sup>

Based on the request to withdraw,<sup>4</sup> Qwest's petition for pricing flexibility is dismissed without prejudice and this proceeding is terminated. As required by the Protective Order in this proceeding, reviewing parties holding confidential information filed in support of the petition must destroy such information or return it to Qwest.<sup>5</sup> An authorized representative of any reviewing party must certify in writing to the Commission and Qwest that no material whatsoever derived from confidential information has been retained, with the exception of confidential information contained in pleadings submitted on behalf of the reviewing party.<sup>6</sup>
