**ORDER**

By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. The Accounting Policy Division (Division) has under consideration a Request for Review from Hayti School District (Hayti), Hayti, Missouri.<sup>1</sup> Hayti challenges the denial of its application for Funding Year 3 of the schools and libraries universal service support mechanism by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator). Specifically, Hayti requests that their Funding Year 3 FCC Form 471 be considered as timely filed.<sup>2</sup> Upon our review of the record, however, we find that SLD approved funding for Hayti’s Funding Year 3 application, and such funds were not revoked or suspended.<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, the Division dismisses Hayti’s Request for Review as moot.
