ORDER

By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. The Accounting Policy Division has under consideration a Waiver Request filed by Nogales/Santa Cruz County Public Library (Nogales/Santa Cruz), Nogales, Arizona.¹ Nogales/Santa Cruz seeks a waiver of the Commission’s rules governing discounts for services under the schools and libraries universal service support mechanism.² For the reasons set forth below, we dismiss Nogales/Santa Cruz’s Waiver Request as moot.

2. Nogales/Santa Cruz seeks a waiver of our rules governing the filing window with respect to its Funding Year 2 FCC Form 471.³ However, the record reflects that the Schools and Libraries Division of the Universal Service Administrative Company provided discounts to Nogales/Santa Cruz for its Funding Year 2 FCC Form 471.⁴ We therefore dismiss Nogales/Santa Cruz’s Waiver Request as moot.
