**WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS
800MHz SPECIALIZED MOBILE RADIO (SMR) SERVICE GENERAL CATEGORY (851-854
MHz) AND UPPER BAND (861-865 MHz) AUCTION LICENSES**

Report No. AUC-34 (Auction No. 34)

On January 29, 2001, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau) announced that it is prepared to grant applications for 6 licenses to A.R.C. Inc., a winner of the 800 MHz Specialized Mobile Radio (SMR) Service General Category (851-854 MHz) and Upper Band (861-865 MHz) licenses (Auction 34), provided that applicant made its final payment before the deadlines established by the Commission.¹ The payment deadline was February 12, 2001.²

Final payment was received for the 6 licenses by the payment deadline. Accordingly, by this Public Notice we announce the grant of the 800 MHz Specialized Mobile Radio (SMR) Service General Category (851-854 MHz) and Upper Band (861-865 MHz) licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and Section 0.331 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, because it will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
