WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS REQUEST OF JOSEPH J. SIMONS, ESQ., TRUSTEE, TO EXTEND DIVESTITURE TRUST

Pursuant to sections 4(i) and 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 310(d), and sections 0.331 and 20.6 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.331, 20.6, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau grants the request of Joseph J. Simons, Esq., Trustee, to extend for 180 days the duration of the wireless asset divestiture trusts involving PCS license WPQL237 held by Chicago 20 MHz, LLC, and PCS license KNLF236 held by GTE Wireless Cincinnati LLC.
