Applicant: MCI WORLDCOM COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

On February 13, 2001, MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. (WorldCom) withdrew its application that was filed December 20, 2000, requesting authority under section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, 47 U.S.C. § 214(a), and section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue its domestic OnLine Card Services, described as metered use calling card service available to residential and commercial customers.
