## **REPORT AND ORDER** (Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: February 28, 2001 Released: March 9, 2001

By the Chief, Allocations Branch:

- 1. In response to a Petition for Rule Making filed by Bott Communications, Inc. ("Bott"), the Commission has before it for consideration the <u>Notice of Proposed Rule Making</u>, 15 FCC Rcd 15164 (2000), seeking the allotment of Channel 285A at Lowry City, Missouri, as that community's first local FM service. Bott filed comments reiterating its intention to apply for Channel 285A at Lowry City. No other comments were received in response to the <u>Notice</u>.
- 2. We believe the public interest would be served by the allotment of Channel 285A at Lowry City, Missouri, as it will provide the community with its first local FM broadcast service. Channel 285A can be allotted to Lowry City, Missouri, in compliance with the Commission's spacing requirements with a site restriction 13.5 kilometers (8.4 miles) southeast of the community. The site restriction will prevent a short spacing to a construction permit for Station KGAR, Channel 286C1, Garden City, Missouri.
- 3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective April 23, 2001, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, as follows:
