REPORT AND ORDER (Proceeding Terminated)

By the Chief, Allocations Branch:

- 1. In response to a petition filed by Carrie L. Riordan ("Riordan"), the Commission has before it for consideration the <u>Notice of Proposed Rule Making</u>, 15 FCC Rcd 22451 (2000), requesting the allotment of Channel 295A at Ephraim, Wisconsin, as the community's first local transmission service. Riordan filed comments supporting the allotment of Channel 295A at Ephraim. No other comments were received in response to the <u>Notice</u> in this proceeding.
- 2. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting Channel 295A to Ephraim, Wisconsin, as it will provide the community with its first local broadcast service. Channel 295A can be allotted to Ephraim in compliance with the minimum distance separation requirements of the Commission's Rules with a site restriction 3.4 kilometers (2.1 miles) northeast of the community. The site restriction will prevent a short-spacing to Station WOCO, Channel 296A, Oconto, Wisconsin. Since Ephraim is located within 320 kilometers of the U. S.-Canadian border, concurrence of the Canadian Government has been requested for this allotment.
- 3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective May 7, 2001, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, as follows:
