WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS UPPER AND LOWER PAGING BANDS LICENSES

AUCTION EVENT NO. 40

Report No. AUC-40 (Auction No. 40)

On May 31, 2002, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau announced that it was prepared to grant applications for licenses to certain winning bidders in the Upper and Lower Paging Bands Auction (Auction No. 40), provided that each applicant made full and timely payment of the remaining balance of its winning bid(s).¹ The payment deadline was June 10, 2002.²

The Commission received full and timely payment, as required by Section 1.2109(a) of the Commission's rules, for the licenses listed in Attachment A. Accordingly, by this Public Notice, we announce the grant of the Upper and Lower Paging Bands licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and section 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, because it will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
