ORDER

By the Assistant Division Chief, Telecommunications Access Policy Division:

1. We grant the request of Bureau 21, Inc. (Bureau 21) to withdraw its petition. On July 16, 2002, Bureau 21 filed the above-captioned petition.¹ In the petition, Bureau 21 requested the Commission to direct the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) to assign it a carrier identification code (CIC) as a switchless reseller without requiring it to purchase Feature Group D access. On October 24, 2002, Bureau 21 notified the Commission that it had received a CIC and submitted a request to withdraw the above-captioned petition.²

2. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to the authority delegated under sections 0.91 and 0.291 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.91, 0.291, that the request to withdraw the above-captioned petition IS GRANTED.
