## ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT OF REVENUE THRESHOLD

This gives notice that the revenue threshold used for classifying carriers for various accounting and reporting purposes<sup>1</sup> is increased to \$119 million. Section 402(c) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 mandates that we adjust this revenue threshold annually to reflect the effects of inflation since October 19, 1992, at which time the threshold was \$100 million. In accordance with the Act, we adjust the threshold based on the ratio of the gross domestic product chain-type price index (GDP-CPI) in the revenue year and the GDP-CPI for October 19,1992. The revenue threshold for 2001 was determined as follows:

(1)	October 19, 1992 GDP-CPI	91.62
(2)	2001 GDP-CPI	$109.37^3$
(3)	Inflation Factor (line 2 ÷ line 1)	1.1937
(4)	Original Revenue Threshold	\$100 million
(5)	2001 Revenue Threshold (line 3 * line 4)	\$119 million <sup>4</sup>
