**REPORT AND ORDER
(Proceeding Terminated)**

By the Assistant Chief, Audio Division:

1. In response to a Petition for Rule Making filed by Jeraldine Anderson (“Petitioner”), the Audio Division considers herein a *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*¹ proposing the allotment of Channel 232A to Broken Bow, Oklahoma. Petitioner filed comments, a statement, and a supplement to that statement. Radio One Licenses, L.L.C., (“ROL”) filed “Comments and Counterproposal”² and reply comments. In her statement and supplement to that statement, Petitioner requests dismissal of her proposal to allot Channel 232A to Broken Bow.³

2. Petitioner has complied with the provisions of Section 1.420(j) of the Commission’s Rules by filing a declaration as part of her supplement to her statement, in which she states that she has not and will not receive any consideration in return for the dismissal of her Petition for Rule Making in MM Docket No. 02-301. Therefore, we dismiss her Petition for Rule Making in MM Docket No. 02-301.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Rule Making filed by Jeraldine Anderson in MM Docket No. 02-301 IS DISMISSED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that MM Docket No. 02-301 IS TERMINATED.

² ROL’s counterproposal recommended a site restriction of Petitioner’s proposed site for Channel 232A at Broken Bow which would facilitate the resolution of another proceeding impacting on an application filed by ROL. That counterproposal is rendered moot by the dismissal of Petitioner’s rulemaking petition herein.
