**FORFEITURE ORDER**

**Adopted: May 7, 2003**

**Released: May 9, 2003**

By the Chief, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this *Forfeiture Order* (“*Order*”), we issue a monetary forfeiture in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to J Transport, Inc. (“J Transport”), for willful and repeated violation of Section 301 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“Act”).<sup>1</sup> The noted violation involves J Transport’s operation of radio transmitting equipment on the frequency of 151.245 MHz without Commission authorization.

2. On December 27, 2002, the District Director of the Commission’s New York, New York Field Office (“New York Office”) issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (“*NAL*”) in the amount of \$10,000 to J Transport.<sup>2</sup> J Transport has not filed a response to the *NAL*. Based on the information before us, we affirm the forfeiture.

3. **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT**, pursuant to Section 503(b) of the Act,<sup>3</sup> and Sections 0.111, 0.311 and 1.80(f)(4) of the Commission’s Rules (“Rules”),<sup>4</sup> J Transport, Inc. **IS LIABLE FOR A MONETARY FORFEITURE** in the amount of \$10,000 for willfully and repeatedly violating Section 301 of the Act.

4. Payment of the forfeiture shall be made in the manner provided for in Section 1.80 of the Rules within 30 days of the release of this *Order*. If the forfeiture is not paid within the period specified, the case may be referred to the Department of Justice for collection pursuant to Section 504(a) of the Act.<sup>5</sup> Payment shall be made by mailing a check or similar instrument, payable to the order of the “Federal Communications Commission,” to the Federal Communications Commission, P.O. Box 73482, Chicago, Illinois 60673-7482. The payment should note NAL/Acct. No. 200332380006, and FRN 0007-

7917-00. Requests for full payment under an installment plan should be sent to: Chief, Revenue and Receivables Operations Group, 445 12th Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20554.<sup>6</sup>
