## WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS UPPER AND LOWER PAGING BAND LICENSES

## **AUCTION EVENT NO. 40**

## Report No. AUC-40 (Auction No. 40)

On May 7, 2003, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau announced that it was prepared to grant Beeper Network Inc.'s applications for the licenses it won in the Upper and Lower Paging Band auction (Auction No. 40), provided that it made full and timely payment of the remaining balance of its winning bids.<sup>1</sup> Additionally, Scott MacIntyre, an applicant that was not listed on the Prepared to Grant PN, already has made full payment of its winning bid.<sup>2</sup>

The Commission received full and timely payment, as required by section 1.2109(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R § 1.2109(a), for the applications listed in Attachment A. Accordingly, by this Public Notice, we announce the grant of the Upper and Lower Paging band licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and section 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, because it will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
