- 1. The Audio Division has before it a *Notice of Proposed Rule Making* ("*Notice*")¹, issue at the request of Maurice Salsa ("Petitioner"), proposing the allotment of Channel 237A at Clarendon, Texas, as the community's second local service. Petitioner filed no comments in response to the *Notice*. No other comments or expressions of interest were received in response to the *Notice*.
- 2. As stated in the Appendix to the *Notice*, a showing of continuing interest is required before a channel will be allotted. It is the Commission's policy to refrain from making a new allotment to a community absent a *bona fide* expression of interest. Therefore, since comments were not received from the Petitioner supporting the allotment of Channel 237A to Clarendon, Texas, or any other party, the Petition for Rule Making is hereby dismissed.
 - 3. IT IS ORDERED, That the Petition for Rulemaking filed by Maurice Salsa IS DISMISSED.
 - 4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
