By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. On October 9, 2001, Unicom, Inc. (Unicom) filed a Request for Review, seeking review of a decision issued by the Rural Health Care Division (RHCD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company.<sup>1</sup> In its request, Unicom seeks review of funding commitments made by RHCD to Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation.<sup>2</sup> On June 5, 2003, Unicom submitted a request that the Request for Review, along with all related Supplements and Petitions for Leave to File, be dismissed with prejudice.<sup>3</sup>
