By the Assistant Chief, Audio Division:

1. In response to a petition filed by Paul B. Christensen ("Petitioner"), the Audio Division of the Media Bureau has before it for consideration the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("Notice")*<sup>1</sup> proposing the allotment of Channel 291A at Knoxville, Illinois, as the community's second local FM transmission service. Petitioner did not file comments supporting the requested allotment, nor were comments received from any other party.

2. As stated in the Appendix to the *Notice*, a showing of continuing interest is required before a channel will be allotted. It is the Commission's policy to refrain from making an allotment to a community absent an adequate expression of interest. Petitioner has not demonstrated a continuing interest in the requested allotment.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the petition for rule making filed by Paul Christensen IS DISMISSED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
