ORDER

By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. The Telecommunications Access Policy Division has under consideration a Request for Review filed by Santa Ana Unified School District, Santa Ana, California (Santa Ana).¹ Santa Ana requests review of a decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator).² For the reasons set forth below, we deny the Request for Review.

2. In its decision, SLD returned Santa Ana's FCC Form 471 because it did not comply with minimum processing standards.³ Specifically, Santa Ana did not indicate the category of service in Block 5, item 11 of the FCC Form 471 for each of the funding requests.⁴ Santa Ana argues that SLD should be reversed because Santa Ana's letter appealing the decision

was filed in a timely manner and included a corrected FCC Form 471.⁵ We find, however, that SLD's decision is consistent with our precedent and affirm substantially for the reasons stated by SLD.⁶

3. Further, construing Santa Ana's argument as a request for a waiver of the FCC Form 471 filing window, we find that a waiver is not appropriate.⁷ A waiver from the Commission is appropriate if special circumstances warrant a deviation from the general rule, and such deviation would better serve the public interest than strict adherence to the general rule.⁸ Santa Ana has not presented any special circumstances warranting a waiver of the filing window.⁹ Therefore, we affirm SLD and deny the Request for Review.

4. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to authority delegated under sections 0.91, 0.291, 1.3 and 54.722(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.91, 0.291, 1.3 and 54.722(a), that the Request for Review filed by Santa Ana Unified School District, Santa Ana, California on July 10, 2002 IS DENIED.
