**Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Extends Deadline for Filing Reply Comments on the
Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in CC Docket No. 94-102, IB Docket No. 99-67,
FCC 02-326**

By this Public Notice, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau) extends the time for filing reply comments on its Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking concerning possible revisions to its enhanced 911 rules.¹ The time for filing reply comments is changed from March 11, 2003 to March 25, 2003.

On December 20, 2002, the Commission released its Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above captioned dockets. On February 19, 2003, the Commission received the initial comments in this proceeding. Given the broad scope of the proceeding and to fully develop the record, the Bureau takes this action on its own motion to extend the deadline for filing reply comments in this proceeding to March 25, 2003.
