On August 22, 2002, Corban Communications, Inc (Corban) filed an application with the Commission requesting authority under section 214(a) of the Act<sup>1</sup> and section 63.71 of the Commission's rules<sup>2</sup> to discontinue the provision of select interstate microwave transmission services.<sup>3</sup> Subsequently, on March 14, 2003, Corban filed a letter withdrawing its application to discontinue services. We hereby grant Corban's request to withdraw its section 214 application.
