FCC ANNOUNCES CONFERENCE CALL MEETING OF THE NORTH AMERICAN NUMBERING COUNCIL

The North American Numbering Council (NANC) has scheduled a meeting to be held by conference call on Monday, May 3, 2004, from 2:30 PM EST until 3:30 PM EST.
