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WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU ANNOUNCES IT IS PREPARED TO GRANT UPPER AND LOWER PAGING BAND LICENSES UPON FULL AND TIMELY PAYMENT

AUCTION EVENT NO. 48

Report No. AUC-48 (Auction No. 48)

On May 28, 2003, the Federal Communications Commission completed the auction of 10,202 licenses in the Lower and Upper Paging Bands ("Auction No. 48"). In this auction, 96 winning bidders won a total of 2,832 licenses.¹ After a preliminary review of the FCC long-form applications (FCC Form 601), the applications listed in Attachment A to the May 30, 2003 Public Notice were accepted for filing.²

By this Public Notice, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau announces that it is prepared to grant the applications for the licenses listed in Attachment A to this Public Notice, upon the full and timely payment of the remaining balance of the applicant's winning bid(s). Such payment must be received by the Commission within ten (10) business days after the date of this Public Notice (*i.e.*, by **January 26, 2004**). See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2109(a). If the winning bidder listed on Attachment A fails to pay the balance of its winning bids in a lump sum by **January 26, 2004**, it may pay the remaining balance within ten (10) business days after the payment deadline (*i.e.*, by **February 9, 2004**), provided that it also pays a late fee equal to five percent of the amount due. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2109(a).

If the winning bidder listed in Attachment A fails to pay the balance of its winning bid(s) by the late payment deadline of **February 9, 2004**, it will be in default and subject to applicable default payments. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.2104(g), 1.2109(c). Such applicant will be assessed default penalties as prescribed by sections 1.2104(g) and 1.2109(c) of the Commission's rules. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.2104(g), 1.2109(c).

Payment Instructions

All payments must be made in U.S. currency in the form of a wire transfer. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 1.2107(b). No personal checks, cashier's checks or other forms of payment will be accepted.

Wire transfer payments must be received by Mellon Bank no later than **6:00 p.m. Eastern Time, January 26, 2004 (or 6:00 p.m. Eastern Time, February 9, 2004, along with the five percent late fee)**. The applicant should allow sufficient time for the wire transfer to be initiated and for the transmission to be completed prior to the deadline. To submit funds by wire, the applicant will need the following information to properly effect the transmittal:

Payments must be preceded by a completed FCC Remittance Advice Form (FCC Form 159). The applicant must fax, on the same business day that it pays the balance due to Mellon Bank, a completed FCC Form 159 to Mellon Bank at (412) 209-6045 at least one hour prior to placing the order for the wire transfer. On the FCC Form 159, the applicant must use the same FRN number used on its FCC Form 601.

When completing FCC Form 159 (February 2003 Version), the applicant must type the auction number, "48," in Block(s) 28A and 28B ("FCC Code 1"). The applicant also must type the applicable license numbers in Blocks 29A and 29B ("FCC Code 2") of FCC Form 159. License numbers should be identified by typing the appropriate radio code ("CP," "GC," or "CZ"), followed by the market designator (BEA), followed by the market number (001-176), and the frequency block (blocks A, B and C). An example of a correct license number would be "CPBEA002E01" or "CZBEA058B." The radio service code, market designator, market number, and frequency block designations are listed in Attachment A. Form 159 provides sufficient boxes to list only two licenses. The applicant must then use FCC Form 159-C ("Continuation Sheet") for the remainder of their licenses.
