By the Assistant Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau:

1. The Audio Division has before it a Notice of Proposed Rule Making issued in response to a petition for rule making filed by Paul B. Christensen, Esquire (Petitioner), requesting the allotment of Channel 283C2 at Islamorada, Florida, as the community's first local service.

2. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting Channel 283C2 at Islamorada, Florida. Islamorada is a community for allotment purposes, deserving of a first local service.

3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority found in 47 U.S.C. Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) and 47 C.F.R. Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283, IT IS ORDERED, That effective January 6, 2005, the FM Table of Allotments, 47 C.F.R. Section 73.202(b), IS AMENDED for the community listed below, as follows:

2 Islamorada is an incorporated village known as, "Islamorada, Village of Islands" with its own mayor and village council, fire and police departments, and schools.

4. A filing window period for Channel 283C2 for Islamorada, Florida will not be opened at this time. Instead, the issue of opening this allotment for auction will be addressed by the Commission in a subsequent order.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the aforementioned proceeding IS TERMINATED.
