The Region 7 (Colorado) 700 MHz/4.9 GHz Public Safety Frequency Advisory Committee (FAC) announces that its first planning meeting will be held on Thursday, December 16, 2004 at 8:30 a.m., at the North Metro Fire Rescue Headquarters Training Room, 10550 Huron Street, Northglenn, Colorado. The purpose for this meeting is to prepare a plan for presentation by the work group to the Regional Planning Committee, which is seeking recommendations and or approval of their submittal. Region 7 Public Safety Planning Committee for 700 MHz and 4.9 GHz spectrum meeting will also be held at the same location but will not start until 10:00 a.m.

The Region 7 700 MHz Public Safety Planning Committee and FAC meetings are open to the public. All eligible public safety providers whose sole purpose or principal purpose is to protect the safety of life, health, or property in Colorado would utilize these frequencies. It is essential that not only public safety, but all government, Native American Tribal, and non-governmental organizations eligible under Section 90.523 of the Commission's Rules be represented in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate and represent your agency's needs.

All interested parties wishing to participate in the planning for the use of either the new public safety spectrum in the 700 MHz band and/or the newly allocated 4.9 GHz band within Region 7 are encouraged to attend.
