FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION'S (FCC) REPORTING REQUIREMENT FOR LONG DISTANCE CARRIERS APPROVED BY THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET

CC Docket No. 94-129

On November 30, 2004, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) approved for three years the information collection requirements contained in the *Implementation of Subscriber Carrier Selection Changes Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996; Policies and Rules Concerning Unauthorized Changes of Consumers' Long Distance Carriers*, Third Order on Reconsideration, CC Docket No. 94-129, FCC 03-42, 18 FCC Rcd 5099 (rel. March 17, 2003) (*Third Order on Reconsideration*). See OMB No. 3060-0787. These information collection requirements relate to mandatory reporting requirements which apply to Local Exchange Carriers. See 47 CFR Sections 64.1120 (c)(3)(iii), 64.1130(j), 64.1150(b), 64.1160(g), 64.1170(g), 64.1180 regarding the requirements concerning local exchange carrier verification of inbound carrier changes, and certifications to exempt carriers from the drop-off requirement. As stated in the *Third Order on Reconsideration*, the effective date of these approved rules is the date notice of the OMB approval is published in the *Federal Register*.

FCC NOTICE REQUIRED BY THE PAPERWORK REDUCTION ACT
