By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

Before the Telecommunications Access Policy Division is a Request for Review filed by the Ralls Independent School District (Ralls ISD), Ralls, Texas, seeking review of decisions by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator) to deny funding.¹ On May 9, 2001, Ralls ISD requested that its Request for Review be withdrawn.²
