ORDER

By the Regional Director, South Central Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this *Order*, we set aside, on our own motion, the *Forfeiture Order*¹ in the above-captioned matter.² We were recently provided evidence that Mega Communications of St. Petersburg Licensee, L.L.C. (“Mega Communications”) paid \$10,000 on May 11, 2005 in response to the *Notice of Apparent Liability*³ issued by the Tampa Office of the Enforcement Bureau. The above-captioned matter should have been closed with Mega Communications’ payment of the \$10,000 proposed forfeiture. Therefore, we cancel the \$10,000 forfeiture issued to Mega Communications in the June 21, 2005 *Forfeiture Order*.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that, pursuant to Section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934 as amended,⁴ and Sections 0.11, 0.311, 1.80(f)(4) and 1.113 of the Commission’s Rules,⁵ the forfeiture in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) issued to Mega Communications of St. Petersburg Licensee, L.L.C. in the June 21, 2005 *Forfeiture Order* **IS CANCELED**.
