### **REGION 29 (NEW MEXICO) 700 MHz PUBLIC SAFETY PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Region 29 (New Mexico) 700 MHz Public Safety Planning Committee announces that its next meeting will be held on Friday, October 7 2005. The meeting will start at 1:30 p.m. (MST) at the Bernalillo County 911 Dispatch Center, 10401 Holly NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico. The purpose of the meeting is to elect board members, appoint a planning committee, and a committee to review adjacent state plans.

The Region 29 700 MHz Public Safety Planning Committee meeting is open to the public. All eligible public safety providers whose sole or principal purpose is to protect the safety of life, health, or property in Region 29 would utilize these frequencies. It is essential that not only public safety, but all government, Native American Tribal, and non-governmental organizations eligible under Section 90.523 of the Commission's Rules be represented in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate and represent their agency's needs.
