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WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS REGIONAL NARROWBAND PCS SPECTRUM LICENSES

AUCTION EVENT NO. 51

Report No. AUC-51 (Auction No. 51)

On December 1, 2005, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau announced that it was prepared to grant an application for a winning bidder in the regional narrowband Personal Communications Service ("regional narrowband PCS") (Auction No. 51), provided that the applicant made full and timely payment of the remaining balance of its winning bid.¹ The payment deadline was December 30, 2004.

The Commission received full and timely payment, as required by Section 1.2109(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.2109(a), for the application listed in Attachment A. Accordingly, by this Public Notice, we announce the grant of the regional narrowband PCS licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and Section 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, because it will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
