FORFEITURE ORDER

Adopted: June 21, 2006

Released: June 23, 2006

By the Regional Director, Western Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this *Forfeiture Order* (“*Order*”), we issue a monetary forfeiture in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to William W. Scrugham (“Scrugham”), for willfully and repeatedly violating Section 301 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“Act”).¹ The noted violation includes operating an unlicensed radio transmitter on 100.3 MHz in Kamiah, Idaho.

2. On March 27, 2006, the Acting District Director of the Enforcement Bureau’s Seattle Office issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (“*NAL*”) in the amount of \$10,000 to Scrugham.² The *NAL* was delivered to Scrugham by regular mail by the United States Postal Service,³ and by hand by the Idaho County Sheriff’s Department. Despite these contacts, Scrugham has not filed a response to the *NAL*. Based on the information before us, we affirm the forfeiture.

3. **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED** that, pursuant to Section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“Act”),⁴ and Sections 0.111, 0.311 and 1.80(f)(4) of the Commission’s Rules,⁵ William W. Scrugham, **IS LIABLE FOR A MONETARY FORFEITURE** in the amount of \$10,000 for willfully and repeatedly violating of Section 301 of the Act.⁶

4. Payment of the forfeiture shall be made in the manner provided for in Section 1.80 of the Rules within 30 days of the release of this *Order*. If the forfeiture is not paid within the period specified, the case may be referred to the Department of Justice for collection pursuant to Section 504(a) of the

Act.⁷ Payment of the forfeiture must be made by check or similar instrument, payable to the order of the Federal Communications Commission. The payment must include the NAL/Acct. No. and FRN No. referenced above. Payment by check or money order may be mailed to Federal Communications Commission, P.O. Box 358340, Pittsburgh, PA 15251-8340.
