By the Deputy Chief, Policy Division, Media Bureau:

1. On October 3, 2005, MetroCast Cablevision of New Hampshire, LLC (“MetroCast”) filed with the Commission a retransmission consent complaint against Viacom, Inc. (“Viacom”), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.65.

2. In a Joint Motion to Withdraw Complaint, filed on January 19, 2006, MetroCast and Viacom state that they have engaged in negotiations for retransmission consent for WBZ and WSBK. The parties jointly seek to withdraw MetroCast’s complaint and ask the Commission to terminate this proceeding.

3. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the Motion to Withdraw Complaint filed by MetroCast and Viacom **IS GRANTED** and the retransmission consent complaint filed on October 3, 2005 **IS DISMISSED**.

4. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by § 0.283 of the Commission’s rules. 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
