## WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU ANNOUNCES PUBLIC TRAINING FOR FCC FORM 608 FILING INTERFACE (SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 7, 2006)

The Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) will be deploying the filing interface for the FCC Form 608 Application or Notification for Spectrum Leasing Arrangement or Private Commons Arrangement.

The new FCC Form 608 is being added to the Universal Licensing System (ULS) License Manager to implement the FCC's policies adopted in its *Secondary Markets* proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Parties will use FCC Form 608 for purposes of notifying the FCC of or seeking FCC authority to enter into Spectrum Leasing Arrangements. The hands-on training will include the following:

- Filing Spectrum Leasing Arrangements with Form 608 online;
- Searching leases and lease applications with ULS License Search and Application Search

The WTB will hold a hands-on public training session of the new interface on Thursday, September 7, 2006, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. The event will take place in TW-B445A in the Portals II building, at the Commission's Washington, DC headquarters, located at 445 Twelfth Street, SW. Interested parties are required to pre-register for the training by September 6, 2006.

### **Registration**

Pre-registration is required.
