I. COST ALLOCATION MANUAL REVISION

1. In this public notice, we seek comment on the Cost Allocation Manual (CAM) revision filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) on September 15, 2006. Qwest's revision reflects changes to the chart of affiliates and transactions with affiliates sections of the CAM, including new services that will be provided in accordance with the Commission's *OI&M Order*.¹

II. PROCEDURAL MATTERS

2. This matter shall be treated as a "permit-but-disclose" proceeding in accordance with the Commission's *ex parte* rules.² Persons making oral *ex parte* presentations are reminded that memoranda summarizing the presentations must contain summaries of the substance of the presentations and not merely a listing of the subjects discussed. More than a one- or two-sentence description of the views and arguments presented is generally required.³ Other rules pertaining to oral and written *ex parte* presentations in permit-but-disclose proceedings are set forth in section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules.⁴

3. Interested parties may file comments on or before October 30, 2006, and reply comments on or before November 14, 2006. All such filings shall refer to the internal file number: **WCB/Pricing**
