NATIONAL EXCHANGE CARRIER ASSOCIATION'S REQUEST TO WITHDRAW ITS PETITION FOR INTERIM WAIVER AND RULEMAKING CONCERNING THE COMPENSATION OF WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SERVICE (TRS) CALLS IS GRANTED

CG Docket No. 03-123

On December 15, 2005, the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) filed a letter with the Commission asking to withdraw its Petition for Interim Waiver and Rulemaking (Petition) concerning the compensation of wireless TRS calls.¹ We grant the request, without prejudice to NECA (or any other interested entity) filing a future petition of this issue.

¹ National Exchange Carrier Association, Petition for Interim Waiver and Rulemaking, CC Docket No. 98-67 (filed July 22, 2002) (requesting that the Commission grant a two-year waiver of its rules governing the jurisdictional separation of costs for intrastate and interstate TRS calls to the extent necessary to permit compensation from the Interstate TRS Fund to relay service providers for all TRS calls placed from wireless telecommunications devices). The Petition is directed at wireless calls routed through the Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN), e.g., initiated via a TTY plugged into a wireless telephone, not wireless IP Relay TRS calls.
