On February 3, 2006, the Satellite Division, Policy Branch, granted with conditions EchoStar Satellite Operating Corporation's (EchoStar's) request for Special Temporary Authority (STA), File No. SAT-STA-20060104-00002. Accordingly, EchoStar is authorized to launch and conduct in-orbit testing of the EchoStar 10 satellite at the 138.5 W.L. orbit location for a period of 60 days commencing on February 8, 2006, in accordance with the terms and technical specifications set forth in its application, the conditions to this grant and the Federal Communications Commission's Rules. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any action on IBFS File No. SAT-LOA-20051221-00267 and SAT-STA-20051130-00257.
